#### Sweet Treats for the Summer

Strawberry Lemonade: (1lb. Strawberries; 1 ½ Cups of Sugar; 2 cups of lemon juice; additional strawberries and lemons for garnish)

- Hull and quarter the strawberries. Place the strawberries in a large bowl, stir in the sugar and ¼ cup lemon juice. Allow to sit, covered for 30 minutes.
- In a countertop blender, blend the strawberry mixture until pureed. Strain the mixture through a fine mesh sieve to get the seeds out.
- In a large bowl, combine the strawberry puree with the remaining 1 3/4 cups of lemon juice and 4 cups of water. Add up to 1 additional cup of water to taste if the mixture is too sweet or strong.
- To serve, stir the lemonade and pour it over ice. Garnish with sliced lemon and strawberries.



## **Blacktop Sealing**

In previous newsletters we advised the community that the seal coating for the black top would commence in early weeks of May.
